

Aquatics GB Swimming Championships 2025 – Event Admissions Policy

1. The management reserves the right to refuse admission to any person without reason being given.
2. The London Aquatics Centre, Everyone Active, its servants, agents or employees, are not under any liability whatsoever in respect of loss or damage to personal property, however caused.
3. No unauthorised persons are permitted to enter the swimming pools or performance area during events.
4. Nuisance of any kind, including, foul, abusive or racial language, or all forms of anti-social behaviour is not permitted and may lead to persecution.
5. Animals will not be permitted to the London Aquatics Centre unless advance written permission has been given by the London Aquatics Centre or Everyone Active, with the exception of police, security and assistance dogs.
6. Prohibited items. Persons in possession of a prohibited item may be refused entry, ejected from the premises or liable for prosecution. Prohibited items include:
 - Items which are or may be illegal;
 - Fireworks, smoke canisters, bottles, glassware, cans, flags, banners, poles, laser pens, and or any other item, which in our reasonable opinion, may cause danger or disruption to any event or to other visitors (regardless of whether or not such item is illegal or is carried for specific purpose);
 - Large bags or suitcases over A3 size;
 - Or food and drink (see below)
7. No food or drink is permitted to be brought into the London Aquatics Centre (except in limited circumstances on proven medical grounds). Only food and drink purchased in the London Aquatics Centre may be consumed in the venue.

8. Everyone Active operates a no smoking policy throughout the London Aquatics Centre including e-cigarettes.
9. Please follow the Aquatics GB Filming and Photography Policy.
10. Customers aged 8 or under must be accompanied by an adult 18+.
