

Where is Immersive Gatsby and how do I get there?

The location is Gatsby's Mansion, Immersive LDN, 56 Davies St, Mayfair, London, W1K 5HR. Nearest tube: Bond Street.

What does 'immersive' mean and what can I expect at Mr Gatsby's party?

'Immersive' means that the environment is designed to deliver an all-encompassing experience; from the moment you enter Gatsby's Drugstore, you will feel like you have been transported to Long Island, back in the roaring 1920's of Jazz-Age America, and are a guest at Mr Gatsby's opulent party where the drama will unfold around you. You may have the opportunity to follow the other guests into smaller rooms and spaces, to learn the Charleston or be able to converse with Mr Gatsby himself, if you are so lucky! You need only interact as much as you are comfortable to – if you prefer to observe from the side-lines, nobody will mind. In fact, Mr Gatsby often enjoys doing exactly that himself!

Is there seating?

As the show is immersive, there is no seating; you will be standing and able to move around the party as it transpires. All tickets are General Allocation with no seat numbers, you are equal in the eyes of Mr Gatsby!

If you require any sort of seating for medical reasons or are unable to stand for prolonged periods of time, please let us know so we can make the necessary arrangements for you – Mr Gatsby is a very accommodating host!

What should I wear?

1920s dress encouraged, not compulsory.

How long is it?

Two and a half hours including interval.

Any age restrictions?

Age recommendation: 14+. Under 18's must be accompanied by an over 18. The Great Gatsby will challenge 25 so ID may be required or you may be refused entry.
