DATES AND TIMES

Wireless Festival will take place on 6 - 8 July 2018 at London's Finsbury Park.

ID FOR TICKETS

ID is **always** required to collect tickets at the box office.

The name on your ticket(s) will be that of the person who purchased them, these can be given to someone else and ID won't be requested for this reason.

ID may be required to verify your age, to find out what ID we accept, go to [event information](#).

AGE RESTRICTIONS

Wireless Festival is not suitable for young children. Children under 5 (aged 4 or below) are notpermitted.

Children under 16 years old (aged 5 -15) must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (18 or over) at all times and will need a full-price ticket.

If you're 16 or older you can attend on your own, please bring ID with you.

ENTERING THE FESTIVAL

If you look under 21, we may ask you to prove your age. If you're under 16 attending with a parent / guardian, we may ask them to prove they're 18 or over.

BUYING ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO

A challenge 21 policy will be in place for all alcohol and tobacco sales on site. If you look under 21, we will need ID from you or we cannot sell you a drink/tobacco.

The only accepted proof of age documents are:

- Passport (not a photocopy, must be valid)
- Photocard Driving License (inc. provisional)
- Proof Of Age Card – the card must be part of the PASS scheme and carry their hologram.
- Northern Ireland Electoral Identity Card

WHAT TO BRING/WHAT NOT TO BRING

WHAT TO BRING / THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Your ticket
- Your Oyster, contactless card or travelcard
- Clothes for any weather eventuality - hat, sunglasses, rainwear, warm clothing
- Sunscreen
- Bring enough cash and/or your card (somewhere to keep it safe) – we have many cash machines on site, all which accept all UK debit cards. Some of the machines will also accept international credit cards. We also have trained engineers on site to manage these machines – please ask for assistance if required. A fee will be charged to use the machines

- Bring ID if you look under 21 in order to be admitted to the festival. You will also need ID if you want to buy alcohol and look 21 or under
- Medication – if you need to bring medication, we recommend bringing a doctor's note or a prescription for it. Please be understanding if we question what you're bringing in as it is important to prevent drugs being brought into the festival
- Remember to tell your friends of any allergies you have
- Check out the latest weather before you leave

DO NOT BRING

- Animals (except assistance dogs)
- Audio visual recording equipment (Professional)
- BBQs
- Balloons
- Bicycles, scooters, roller skates
- Blow torches
- Cans
- Chairs, stools, floor seating, shooting sticks
- Children under 5 (4 and under)
- Chinese lanterns
- Cooking apparatus
- Cool bags / boxes (large)
- Cigarettes (more than for personal use)
- Cutlery
- Drinks (unopened plastic bottles 500ml or less permitted)
- Drones
- Fireworks / pyrotechnics
- Flag with poles
- Flares / distress flares / smoke flares
- Food (small amounts for personal consumption permitted)
- Gazebos
- Gas cylinders
- Glass
- Illegal substances (drugs)
- Laser pens
- Legal highs

- Nitrous oxide / herbal highs
- Megaphones
- Penknives
- Smoke bombs / canisters
- Sound systems
- Spray cans
- Umbrellas (large, small/folding umbrellas permitted)
- Weapons

FOOD & DRINK

You can take snacks and soft drinks into the festival for your own consumption provided that any soft drinks are held in unopened and sealed plastic or paper containers with a capacity of 500ml or less.

If you are bringing snacks and soft drinks, please do so in a carrier bag or small rucksack.

Please don't bring any alcohol or glass containers/bottles of any sort.




BAGS ALLOWED

Large bags are not allowed to be taken into the festival. There are no cloakroom or storage facilities.

Small bags are allowed into the festival with the dimensions W21cm x H30cm x D8cm (A4 Size).

Bags will be searched on entry to the event, to avoid lengthy queues we strongly advise that you do not bring a bag. We appreciate your cooperation and patience when entering the festival. See below for examples:





Bags must not be left at entrances or surrounding areas. Any items left will be removed and disposed of accordingly.

You will also be searched at the entrance to the event which may include a full body pat down and/or use of hand held metal detectors. Any item(s), which may reasonably be considered for use as a weapon, or which may

cause danger or disruption to any other persons at the event, will be confiscated.

Please allow plenty of time to get into the event, and for concert entry procedures, ticket checks and searches.

Persons suspected of carrying items that may be used in an offensive or dangerous manner, or carrying out illegal activities within the arena or other parts of the site may be searched.
